RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS

Domestic violence can happen to anyone.

TYPES OF ABUSE



Physical Abuse – Hitting, pushing, slapping, choking, or any other physical harm.



Emotional Abuse – Humiliation, blaming, manipulation, or constant criticism.



Psychological Abuse – Intimidation, threats, gaslighting, or mind games.



Financial Abuse – Controlling money, preventing access to income or assets.



Digital Abuse – Monitoring calls, texts, social media, or online activity.



Stalking – Following, showing up unwanted, or causing fear.



Isolation – Controlling who you see, where you go, or what you do.



Threats – Threatening you, your children, pets, or loved ones.

WARNING SIGNS / RED FLAGS

- ✓ They control where you go or who you talk to.
- ✓ They check your phone or track your location.
- ✓ They threaten you, your children, or pets.
- ✓ They hurt you—and then apologize or blame you.
- ✓ The abuse is getting worse over time.
- ✓ You feel afraid, walking on eggshells, or trapped.



IF YOU FEEL UNSAFE,
it matters.

STRANGULATION IS A SERIOUS WARNING SIGN.

If someone has strangled you, your risk of being killed increases significantly.
